Record Results Again

We are delighted to report that the school achieved record results in the GCSE examinations for the sixth year running.

96% of leavers achieved at least 5 passes at the highest grades of A*-C, a rise of 2% on last year. 70% achieved at least 5 grades at A*-C, including English and mathematics, which is 10% above last year's figure. We are also pleased that more than 50% of leavers achieved at least one A* or A grade, with 34% achieving at least 3 grades at A* or A. Boys are now achieving at the same level as girls and in some areas are out-performing them.

Everyone involved with the school is extremely pleased with these results, which reflect the hard work of students and staff, along with the excellent support we receive from parents. Our targets for 2011 are even higher, but we are confident that our current Year 11 can meet these targets and achieve record results once again.

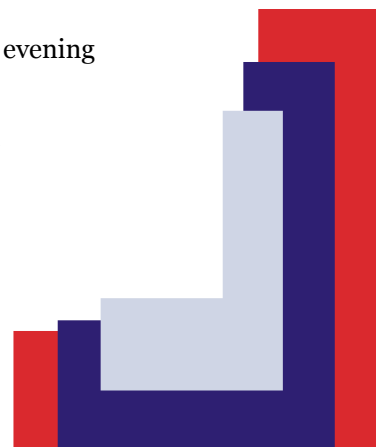
