SCHOOL ADMISSIONS ARRANGEMENTS - 2020/2021 SCHOOL YEAR AND TEMPORARY REVISIONS TO PAN – 2019/20

Introduction

The Governing Body is required to determine its 2020/2021 admission arrangements by 28 February 2019, ensuring that they are compatible with the area's co-ordinated admission arrangements. The determined arrangements must be forwarded to the Local Authority by 15 March 2019 and placed on the schools website. Any objections to those arrangements must then be made to the Schools Adjudicator by 15 May 2019.

No changes are proposed to the present co-ordinated school admission arrangements.

Proposed Admission Number

The arrangements must also include the admission number for the year of entry to the school.

The Governing Body is asked to note that the indicated admission number for 2020/21 is **224** and is recommended that this stays the same. However, it has been recently agreed at an Extra-Ordinary Governor Committee on the 19 September 2018 to temporarily raise the PAN for 2019-2020 from 224 to 254. This has been done to accommodate the increasing pupil numbers from our primary feeder schools. (See attached schedule).

The Local Authority has previously arranged for the formal consultation to be carried out on behalf of all schools in the Borough. Accordingly, a copy of the draft policy should be forwarded to the School Admissions Team once this has been confirmed.

The Local Authority's co-ordinated school admission arrangements also impact on the Governing Body's admission policy. There are no proposed changes to those arrangements at the present time.

Recommendation

The Governing Body is asked:

- a) to receive the report and determine the admission arrangements for the school for the 2020/2021 school year;
- b) request that the Headteacher forward a copy of the arrangements to the LA by 2 December 2018.

- c) determine, as part of the admission arrangements, an admission number of **254** for the year of entry to the school for the 2019/2020 school year and advise the LA.
