

RE: Hungerhill Rome Trip 2020

Dear parents/carers,

We are delighted to announce that we are now accepting deposits for the Rome trip, taking place in the May half term holiday of 2020 (Friday 22nd to Monday 25th May).

The aim of the trip is to provide students with an enriching experience outside the normal curriculum; the trip is open to all current year 8 and 9 students, regardless of the curriculum they study.

The cost of the trip is £815 and payments can be made in instalments. The cost includes:

- 4 days in Rome
- Coach Transfers, return flights and transport whilst in Italy
- Accommodation in central Rome for 3 nights in a 3* hotel just meters from the Colosseum
- Breakfast at the hotel with lunches and evening meals at a local restaurant including a pizza making experience
- Guided tour of the Colosseum, Roman Forum and St Peter's Basilica, visits to the Trevi fountain, Pantheon, Vatican City and the Catacombs of St. Callixtus as well as a visit to the nearby archaeological site of Ostia Antica
- Time Elevator 5D cinema experience
- Guided surfing excursion at Hibiscus beach, Ostia, including surf training and an afternoon at the beach

The trip is a fantastic experience for students and covers a range of cultural, historical, spiritual and active experiences. There are only 30 places available and in the event that the trip is oversubscribed we will offer places based on a lottery. We will hold reserve places should any students drop out. We reserve the right to refuse places/remove students from the trip in the event of poor attitude to learning, behaviour or poor attendance and punctuality.
