Students will need to arrive at school **no later than 8.20am** to ensure a prompt departure to the Centre. We will return to school in time for the school buses.

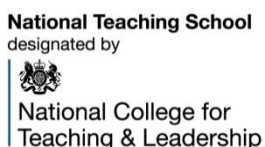
Other information
