

How to access homework on Frog – Student Guide

2. Watch the tutorial on this page to show you how to login from home.

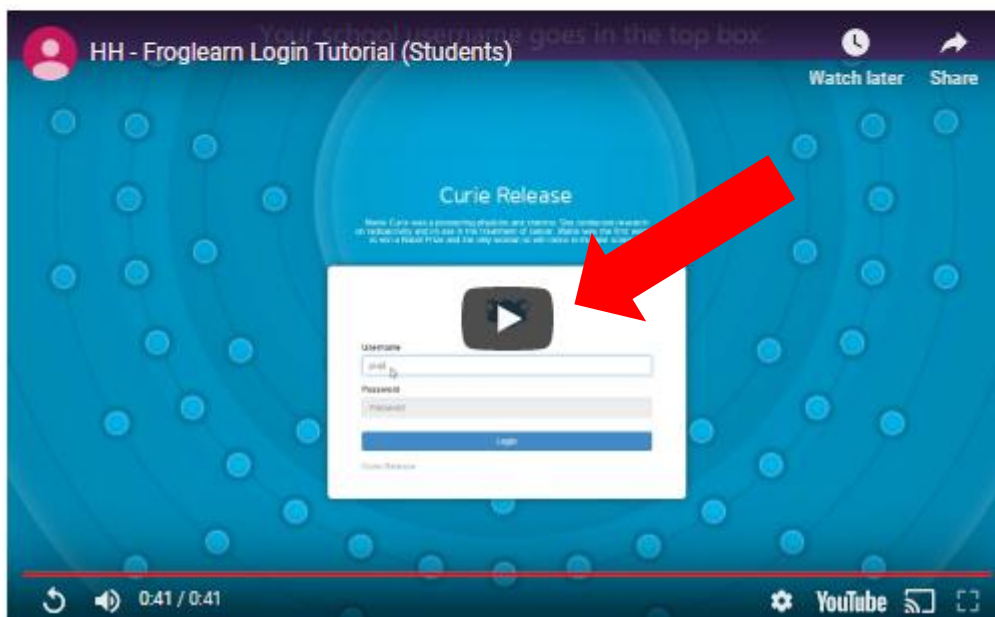
