As you will be aware the school has high expectations in terms of student behaviour and general conduct. We are pleased to say that the majority of our students conduct themselves with respect both in and out of school. Unfortunately, in recent weeks we have had to address the behaviour of a small minority of students who, at the end of the school day, have not demonstrated the high levels of respect and good conduct we would expect of all our students.


We therefore are writing to you as parents and carers to ask for your support by reminding your children of our expectations around their behaviour in the community. Please would you spend some time reaffirming the following:

- Behaviour on public transport including school buses should be courteous and respectful at all times.
- Students should avoid any actions which may compromise the health and safety of others
- Students should not trespass on private property and should show our local residents the good manners we expect and apply in school.
- Wilful acts of vandalism or aggression will not be tolerated from any student

We would like to remind parents and carers that the school's behaviour policy applies as students are travelling to and from school. This policy can be seen in full detail on our website. Parents and students should be clear that any constant breach of the behaviour policy could lead to an exclusion.
