Dear Parents/Carers,

The schools in the Brighter Futures Learning Partnership Trust will continue to respond to the latest government advice with regards to the Coronavirus. As you are aware we are monitoring this at regular intervals on a daily basis. On Monday 16 March, the Prime Minister announced the following:

“Anyone with a fever or persistent cough should stay at home for 14 days. This measure also extends to anyone who lives with someone displaying coronavirus symptoms.”

**Postponed events:**


Year 9 Parents’ Evening – Thursday 19 March
