The ROA provides pupils with the opportunity to review their progress to date and set targets for the future.

The list below shows some of the criteria used by staff to assess pupil effort but detailed descriptors for attitude to learning and attitude to homework grades are given separately at the end of the report. There is also a supplementary sheet at the back of the report showing your child's events for the current academic year.

- * Homework
- * Equipment and organisation
- * Presentation of work
- * Research - taking the work further
- * Meeting coursework deadlines
- * Attitude - enthusiastic, helpful, positive
- * Concentration, responsiveness in lessons
- * Pattern of test results as a measure of progress and effort

Pupils are aware of these criteria and how they apply to each of their KS4 courses. The Headteacher commends pupils with consistently outstanding attitude to learning across a range of subjects. Cases of poor or disappointing attitude to learning are fully investigated.

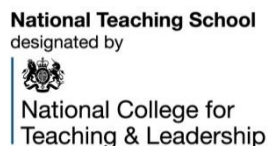

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
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This is a crucial report for Year 11 pupils and it is vital that the advice given by subject teachers in the areas for improvement section of the report is acted upon.
