## Re: Key Stage 9 Year Current Grades April 2021

Dear Parent/Carer,

Please find attached a copy of your child's current grades. The purpose of this report is to provide you with information as to how well your son/daughter has been learning since February, both remotely and since their return to face-to-face learning in the classroom. These grades have been based on assessments that students have completed in their various subjects.

If an X result is recorded, this is due to either your child being absent for the assessment or for part of the assessment.

Since 2017, GCSE Grades have been awarded using a new scale shown below. The equivalent grade used on the previous system has been included for comparison. A grade 4 is classed a standard pass; a grade 5 is a strong pass.
