Dear Parents/Carers,

We recently emailed to confirm that a leavers' celebration event for Year 11 students, taking place on Friday 25 June at Castle Park Rugby Club, will go ahead. We are really pleased to be able to offer this opportunity to our Year 11 students and we look forward to them celebrating their time together at Hungerhill School. Planning is now underway, and we are in a position to be able to confirm some further details about the event.

The cost of tickets will be confirmed in due course, but we expect this to be between £20 and £25. The cost of a ticket includes a buffet and drinks voucher for each student and contributes to the general running of the evening. We will not be taking payments until government updates are released on the planned Covid roadmap; we hope this information will be released the week commencing 14th June. All payments will be received electronically through our school system – Simspay. Should parents not be able to pay using this facility, we will be able to provide a bar code pay system as an alternative. Please note that we will not be able to accept cash payments. Further information will be provided following government updates.

Students attending the leavers' event will be required to follow a 'smart/casual' dress code that will mean no tracksuits, hoodies, hats or sports trainers. We hope this adjustment to our traditional 'formal' dress code ensures all students can take part, and the potential financial risks for parents are kept to a minimum.

Students will be welcome to arrive at Castle Park Rugby Club from 6.30pm, with the event officially starting at 7pm and ending at 11pm.

As in our previous correspondence we must remind parents that the leavers' event is dependent on the relaxing of Covid guidelines. It may be necessary to cancel the event at short notice and, as such, we recommend that parents/students do not make any financial commitments to the evening.
