As part of our ongoing programme to support a successful transition from Hungerhill we will be running a series of activities throughout the final week in addition to celebrating and reflecting on the time the students have spent at school.

On Monday 24th and Tuesday 25th students will be undertaking some 'final lesson' activities with their class teachers. This will involve a combination of reflection activities, Post 16 tasters and subject challenges.

Wednesday (26th) and Thursday (27th) will see the year group splinter into their two sectors.

On Wednesday, Sector A will visit the UTC and undertake a day of activities looking at the 21st Century World of Work. Sector B will remain in school to participate in enrichment activities and intra-form sports events. On Thursday, the activities will alternate with Sector B visiting the UTC and Sector A remaining at Hungerhill.

On the day of the visit to the UTC, students will arrive at school as normal, in full school uniform and attend form period where they will be registered. Transport will be provided. Students will return to school for approximately 3:10pm. Lunch can be purchased, or students are welcome to take their own packed lunch.
