Re: Update Letter July 2021

Staggered Return September 2021

The current guidance from the government has recently been released and is instructing schools to conduct initial on-site Coronavirus testing prior to students returning to face-to-face teaching as was the case in the Spring term. As staff are not due to return until Wednesday 1 September, this means that we will have no choice but to implement a staggered return to school. Please see the table below for an outline of how this will run – year groups are for the 2021/22 academic year. Further details with regards to the testing process will follow in the summer holiday. We are hopeful that this current guidance does not change over the course of the summer break. In the event that this happens, we will be in contact with parents/carers.

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Free School Meals – Summer 2021


Students in receipt of free school meals will receive vouchers weekly from the school over the summer holiday, these will be distributed on a Monday.
