### Re: Rewards Update

As you will be aware, rewards are a priority for the school to develop. Currently we are working with the form representatives from each year group to create and launch new events to celebrate our hard-working students. This collaborative work will continue into the New Year but we felt, that as we draw near to the end of term, it was time to give parents/carers an update. We have the following rewards initiatives currently being embedded:

#### Attitude To Learning Celebration Events

In order to reward our students' success, we have introduced AtL celebration events that will take place after each data capture. Those students displaying the highest standards of AtL will be invited to take part in a variety of mixed year group events over the course of the year. Having gathered the thoughts and ideas of our students, we are in the process of exploring a variety of options, including:

- Afternoon tea/guest speaker – tea and cakes served while listening to a motivational speaker/personality
- Trips to theme parks/local attractions

#### Daily Rewards

- Students are rewarded with bonus credits for contributions in lesson and home learning
- Core value bonus credits acknowledge the students who endeavour to work to embed this culture in our school and community

#### Weekly Rewards

Each week students with the highest number of bonus credits are awarded the Gold Star Pin. This allows students to be first in line for the lunch queue. Additional to this, they are invited to the weekly Wednesday break time treat, where we are currently providing them with a treat and hot chocolate.

#### Attendance Rewards

Attendance comes with its own reward in terms of better grades, but along with this Hungerhill School would like to celebrate excellent attendance with rewards.

- Each half term the form with the highest attendance for the year group are invited to the fabulous form breakfast. Student voice shared they wanted a full English, so this is being provided for this half term


- Christmas Advent was our way of celebrating 100% attendance week on week for the four weeks up to Christmas. Each form was entered into its own prize draw.  
 Week 1: Christmas selection boxes were awarded  
 Week 2: £10 love to shop vouchers were awarded  
 Week 3: £20 amazon vouchers were awarded  
 Week 4: All 97%-100% attendance students (for the term) will be taken to the Savoy Cinema. The school is pleased to announce that we initially reserved the venue for 450 students but a staggering 721 have managed to reach this attendance threshold and have secured a place.  
 Additional to this there will be a £50 Tesco voucher to win for each year group for all the students who attend for 100% for the entire Advent time. This is our way to celebrate and support our families this year.

We look to continue developing our rewards packages and taking on board the excellent ideas that come through the form representatives.

We are very excited to be able to introduce the above events for this year and we hope your son/daughter will endeavor to be part of the celebrations. All students have been made aware of these opportunities but we would also encourage discussions between parents/carers and students about the importance of a positive attitude and the rewards on offer.
