## Re: Year 11 Easter Intervention

Throughout the last 12 months, you will be aware of the huge efforts we have made as a school to offer additional learning opportunities to students in attempts to recoup the lost learning caused by the Covid-19 pandemic. This has included the increased use of Microsoft Teams, the extension of the school day and staff delivering sessions during school holiday periods.

We are truly on the final stretch now with Year 11 and in most subjects, courses have now completed, and lessons are focussing on revision for their final exams that commence on Monday 16 May. To support this, students have been provided with advance information produced by the exam boards that will help focus their revision.
