Keep your diaries clear as it looks like it's going to be an amazing experience as staff and students all come together to take part in a 5k run or walk. Students will be able to register for Parkrun, bring their barcode and receive an official time (as they sprint past Mr Storey and Mrs Laidlaw) or they can just do it for fun. Either way, all students will receive a medal for their efforts.

There will be refreshments and a cake stall, and we hope that many of you will come and support us on the day, especially as Harry and all his family will be there.
