We are excited to inform you about a school-based initiative to enhance students' engagement in the wider curriculum: The Hungerhill Strive for 5 Passport! At Hungerhill, we aim to prepare our students academically, socially and personally for the opportunities, challenges and responsibilities of life in the 21st century. Through focusing on our core values, we want to help students become well-rounded individuals who make a positive contribution to the school and community they live in, leading to them building confidence and being better prepared for life beyond Hungerhill.
