Please read the following information about the future celebrations for the year group.

### Prom Information

It is my pleasure to inform you that we have secured a venue for the Year 11 Prom for the Hungerhill school class of 2023 and would like to ask you to save the date.

The Prom will take place at, Castle Park, Armthorpe Road, Doncaster, DN2 5QB on June 23. Students should arrive between 6:30-7.00pm and they should be collected at 11:00pm.

After the amazing send off for our Class off 2022 we are really excited about the upcoming preparations for this year's cohort and want to give every student every opportunity to join their fellow students in celebrating the completion of their GCSE's and moving on to the next stage of their lives.

This school year at Hungerhill School we are running an initiative that is called '*Passport To The Prom*'. This is to incentivise students to achieve the best they can achieve in all areas within this crucial final year at Hungerhill school.

It starts with all students being awarded 10 points and therefore by default being in a qualifying position to go to the prom. The loss of all 10 points by the end of June 2023 will lead to the withdrawal of their invitation to the Hungerhill Class of 2023 Prom.

Prom points will be given out starting with the initial 10 as previously mentioned, but students can be awarded points as well as losing points. Students must qualify in June 2023 with a minimum of 1 prom point in order to retain their invitation to the Prom. We will provide further information about the cost of the prom in the coming year.


### Leavers Hoodies
