We would like to invite you to attend our Parents' Evening on **Wednesday 17 November 2022, 4 pm – 7pm.** This is an important evening and provides you with an opportunity to discuss your child's progress with their teachers. We encourage students to be involved with their parents/carers during the evening.

Whilst this evening will take place in school, the school will continue to use the online appointment booking system called 'SchoolCloud' which you will be familiar with from previous virtual evenings. SchoolCloud is currently the most popular parents' evening software in the UK and allows you to choose your own appointment times with teachers or it can arrange these times for you, subject to availability. Please note in order to provide all parents with an opportunity to speak to teachers, the meetings will be for a maximum of 5 minutes with each class teacher and there are 5 minute breaks between appointments to allow movement from one teacher to the next.
