As we embark on the final term for our Year 11 students' we are excited to announce the sale of our Class of 2023 Prom tickets!

As previously communicated this year's prom will be held on Friday 23 June at Castle Park Rugby Club, Armthorpe Rd, DN2 5QB. Students may arrive from 6:00 pm and the event will draw to a close at 11pm. Tickets will be available to purchase from Friday 12 May and priced at £35. Payment can be made via <a href="https://www.pay360educationpayments.com">https://www.pay360educationpayments.com</a> with a deadline for purchase of **9 am on 26 May**. If you have not paid by this point unfortunately your child will not be able to attend. Admission to the event is ticket only, and tickets will be issued to students during Leaver's week and they will need to bring this with them on the evening.

The event includes a buffet, use of a private suite and a disco. A professional photographer will also be present throughout the evening for students to purchase photographs as a memento of the event. These are priced at £10 per print or £25 for 3 prints. Payments for these can be made by cash on the evening.

In previous years, this event has been a very pleasurable way to celebrate the end of this important year.

Conduct in, too and from school during the examination period and up until 24 June must be exemplary in order to qualify for a ticket. Please note, we reserve the right to refund ticket money for any ticket purchased by those who do not qualify to attend the event.















Parents', carers, and students will also understand the need to express the following clear conditions which must be accepted by all those who attend:

- o It must be stressed that the Prom is totally alcohol free. In the event of this condition not being met, staff will not admit a student to the event, and they will need to be collected by a parent/carer.
- Whilst the event has always been celebrated in high spirits previously, it should be noted that students must adhere to the same behaviour policy expected when in school, any negative behaviour displayed by students will result in them being ejected from the event.

The Prom is a wonderful opportunity for students to celebrate the end of their time at Hungerhill in a venue which is very fitting for such an excellent group of young people.

We look forward to sharing this occasion with our students on the evening.
