

Parental Consent – Use of Photos and Videos

At Hungerhill School, we use information about your child in different ways. This includes the use of student images and we'd like your consent for some of the ways these images are used.

We take photos of students for use on our management information system for safeguarding purposes.

We sometimes take additional photos and video recordings of students to demonstrate what life in our school is like, or as a learning tool for students to progress in their subjects.

Under the current data protection and GDPR regulations, to use your child's image in the ways listed we need positive affirmation of your consent. If you consent to some of the ways we use your child's image, simply tick the relevant box on the electronic registration form against the ones you do give your consent for and leave the others blank. By leaving some of the boxes blank this will signify that you do not give consent for us to use the images in that way.
