




## Hungerhill Parents Advisory Group (HPAG)

Item	Main points	Actions
<b>Welcome and introductions</b>	LPO welcomed all attendees and thanked them for their attendance and continued support. The forum provides an opportunity for transparent conversations and for the school to receive feedback from our key stakeholders.	
<b>Actions from previous meeting</b>	Home Learning – recommendations to further enhance initiatives to promote home learning. Review inclusion of home learning in AtoL matrix – review for academic year 24/25 ClassCharts – Reward Shop launched successfully. Message to Y11 to 'spend' their credits GCSE booster plan being executed successfully. Plan for leavers week also in place. Yonde Wallet continues to be investigated with an implementation plan looking at December. Parents, students and staff will be fully consulted prior.	
<b>Planners</b>	Review of the use of the student planners. An audit has been completed obtaining student and staff voice to date. Questions posed around usage, usefulness and preference for usage next academic year.	If removed - What will replace the student planner for the parent/school communication? E.g informing of appointments. Alternatives for teaching and learning tools that are currently included? E.g periodic table? Where will students retain their timetable? Supports transition – could it be just used for Y7? Can size be reduced?

<p><b>SMSC</b></p>	<p>A reminder provided of what SMSC stands for and the schools current approach to developing the whole student. Delivered beyond PSHE and citizenship but is integral to the day to day running of the school and all curriculum areas support the delivery.</p> <p>A handout distributed that provided an outline of how each area (Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural) are developed at Hungerhill. HTU elaborated on elements contained within the supplementary material.</p> <p>The group shared views that they felt the schools work has been exemplary in this area.</p>	
<p><b>Enrichment and Interform</b></p>	<p>An update on Enrichment attendance figures shared including disadvantage and SEND figures. The timetable for current Enrichment clubs circulated. Also, the most recent Hungerhill Highlights newsletter (Summer 2024) shared which shows the breadth of opportunities shared.</p> <p>RHA talked through enrichment programme, including inter-form competitions and charity work (over £2500 raised so far)</p>	<p>Continue to review types of clubs offered for academic year 24/25 Continue to roll out the sign in procedures to clubs utilising new technology through InVentry.</p> <p>Can we promote Harry Peace charity day via school communication streams?</p> <p>Include Extra curricular overview as a Highlight to further promote with parents/carers.</p>
