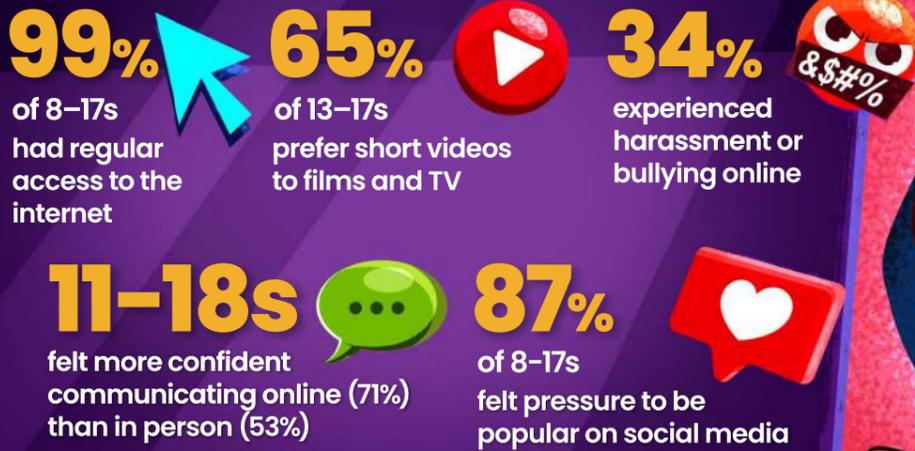


# What Parents & Educators Can Learn from the OFCOM MEDIA REPORT 2024

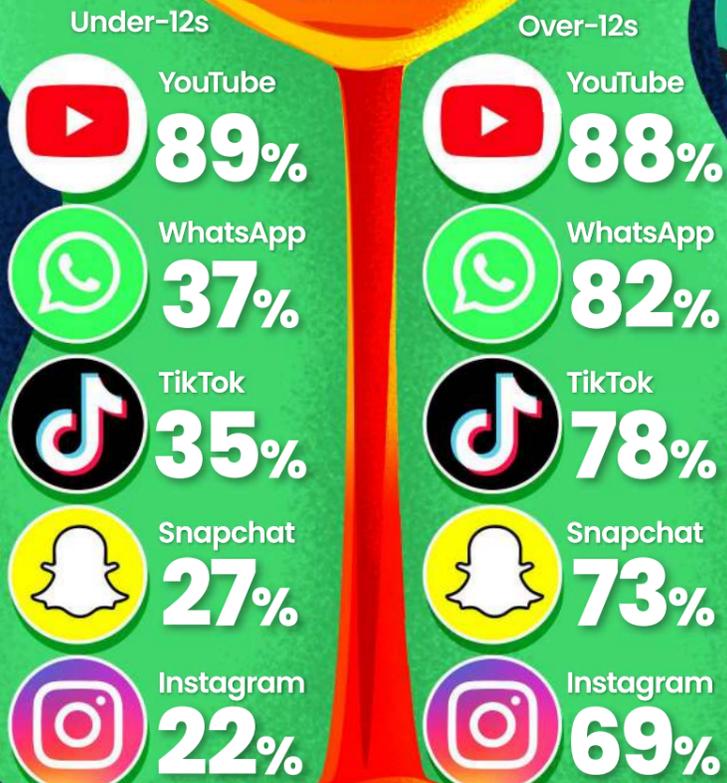
## SCREEN TIME

## ONLINE GAMING


**68%** of children played video games online

Who did these children most commonly play with?

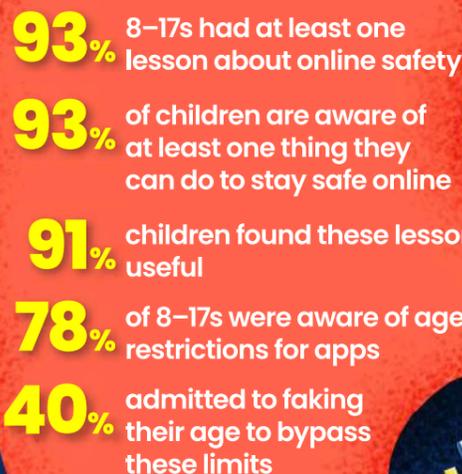
