Dear Parents/Carers,

We can't believe we are writing to you with only a few weeks left before your child begins their GCSE exams and then leaves Hungerhill to begin the new chapter of their educational journey. This is always a time when students and staff feel the pressure of the exams most acutely but also when we prepare for celebrating not only their achievements but also the wonderful young people they have become.

May we take this opportunity to say that we are incredibly proud of our Year 11s who have faced extreme challenges in their education and been very resilient in the process. This leaves us with no doubt that our Year 11s will make every effort to do their very best and achieve their potential; what they have achieved so far, not only academically but also in terms of their personal development and growth, is remarkable given the disruption their education has faced over the past few years.

We thought it would be useful for you to have a reminder of and further information about some key dates around the Year 11 examinations which begin on **6th May** and end on **17th June** and our planned events to celebrate the Hungerhill journey that our Year 11s have been on.

Friday 23rd May (Expected Arrival Date) – School Hoodies Distributed

It is expected that the school hoodies will arrive on Friday 23rd May. Students who have ordered a school leavers' hoodie will be able to collect these after Period 3 on this date if they have arrived. We are happy for students to wear their hoodies after May half term but expect students to wear their blazers in their examinations.

Monday 16th June

After the morning examination, students will spend Period 3 in the sports hall for the traditional shirt signing event. There will also be an ice cream van for our Year 11s and after lunch, a leavers' assembly during Period 4 where we will be able to celebrate the achievements of the year group together.

Friday 27th June – Year 11 Prom

The Prom will take place at Castle Park, Armthorpe Road, Doncaster, DN2 5QB on 27th June. Students should arrive between 6:30-7.00pm and they should be collected at 10:00pm please. Separate letters and arrangements have been sent out but if students wish to discuss the Prom, they should contact Miss Harwood or Ms Archibald.

Thursday 21st August – Results Day

Students will be able to attend school to collect their GCSE results on the morning of 21st August. Your child will be allocated a half hour slot with the rest of their form to collect their results. Further information about this will follow later this term. This will be a chance not only for results collection but also to celebrate with them and say our final goodbyes before they embark on their post-16 journeys.
