Dear Parents/Carers,

**Re: Important Update to Uniform Policy – September 2025**

We are writing to inform you of an important change to the school uniform policy, which will take effect from September 2025. After careful consultation and review, we will be implementing a standardised uniform option for female students to ensure consistency, clarity, and fairness across the school community.

From September 2025, the only permitted lower-body uniform options for female students will be:

- Black **pleated** cotton knee-length skirt, as demonstrated in the image
- Black regular-fit school trousers

Please note: Leggings, skinny trousers, jeggings, or jeans-style trousers will not be permitted. Trousers must be of standard school specification. Skirts must not deviate from the above.



This change is being introduced to eliminate ongoing discrepancies in uniform interpretation and to support both staff and parents in upholding a consistent and appropriate dress code, reinforce our high standards and ensure all students represent Hungerhill School with pride.


