Dear Parents/Carers,

**Re: Creating a Safer Environment Around Hungerhill School**

We have been contacted by Doncaster Council regarding new measures to improve safety outside schools across the borough.

From the week commencing Monday 15 September 2025, camera enforcement will be introduced at several schools in Doncaster, including Hungerhill. The cameras will monitor the "school keep clear" markings and nearby bus stops during school times.

This step has been taken because traditional enforcement has not been effective enough in keeping these areas safe. Parking in restricted zones creates a significant risk for pupils and families by reducing visibility, causing congestion, and making it harder for everyone to move safely around the school site.

The cameras are designed to:

- Improve safety outside the school gates
- Reduce congestion and air pollution
- Encourage families to consider alternative travel options to school

Important note: This enforcement is being carried out entirely by Doncaster Council, not Hungerhill School or the Trust. Any parking fines will be automatically issued by the Council. If you receive a fine and wish to dispute it, please contact Doncaster Council directly via [enforcementteam@doncaster.gov.uk](mailto:enforcementteam@doncaster.gov.uk) The school and Trust have no role in this process and cannot intervene on behalf of individuals.

Please be aware that there will be no exemptions for buses or coaches, and all vehicles must avoid stopping or parking in the restricted areas.

We ask for your full support in keeping our school community safe by following the parking restrictions at all times.

Thank you for your cooperation in helping us keep Hungerhill a safe environment for all.
