**Re: Hungerhill Transition**

We are very much looking forward to welcoming your child to Hungerhill School from September. Transition to secondary school has always been a key milestone for students, we are therefore keen to ensure that both students and parents feel fully supported and informed about how we will be running the transition process over the coming weeks. I would therefore like to clarify the following key dates and information below:

- **Parents and Students Meet the tutor Evening – Tuesday 7 July, half hour slots between 4-5.30.**
- **Student Transition/Induction Days – 9am -2.45pm. Tuesday 7 July, Wednesday 8 July and Thursday 9 July.**
- **Hungerhill Uniform exclusive purchase dates – Uniform can be purchased in store or online from Cliffs/Schoolwear Solutions. Cliffs will be holding exclusive opening hours for Hungerhill parents in store on Thursday 9 July 4:30 to 7:00pm, Thursday 16 July 4:30 to 7:00pm and Sunday 19 July 10:30 to 3:30pm. **Parents and Students Meet the tutor evening.**

All parents/carers and students are invited to attend our Transition Evening on Tuesday 7 July. The evening will be an half hour bookable timeslot for you to meet your child's form tutor, further information about booking on to this evening will be sent nearer the time. It is intended to provide you with up-to-date information about your child's transition to Hungerhill and our values, standards, and expectations. It is an ideal opportunity for you to ask any questions and for us to help you, as a family, prepare for September. Key members of staff including our Pastoral Team, Special Needs and Disabilities Co-Ordinator and members of the Senior Leadership Team will all be available to talk to. A member of our First Aid Team will also be on hand to discuss any medical needs that your child may have, which could impact on their transition to Hungerhill School.

## Student Transition/Induction Days

These will be an exciting and fun packed few days of lessons and learning experiences. For your child to trial a real secondary school day we ask parents/carers to make their own arrangements for students to arrive and be collected from Hungerhill on these days. Feeder school students will be registered by their primary school at the front of Hungerhill, please speak to your Year 6 teacher for specific arrangements. For schools out of catchment, you will be met by staff and students from Hungerhill and directed from there. Please note Years 7 to 9 will be in school as normal but Year 6 students will follow a separate programme for these days. Students are to wear their primary school uniform to ensure they are easily identifiable by Hungerhill staff. **On Wednesday 8 July, students need to attend Hungerhill School in their primary PE kit.** Each day students should bring a packed lunch. Students who usually receive a free school meal should be provided with a packed lunch by their primary school.

All items can be purchased through the link on our website and can be delivered to your home address. Alternatively, you can purchase items in store from our supplier Cliffs/Newplan Solutions.
