Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Transition at Hungerhill July 7th, 8th and 9th July

I hope that this letter finds you well. We are really looking forward to welcoming the new year 7 students to our 3 days of transition in July. We wanted to share some information about what students will need during those 3 days.

Students will be informed about their tutor group prior to arrival on Tuesday 7th July. On arrival at school they will be directed to the main hall where they will sit in their new tutor groups for a welcome assembly. Students will then spend some time with their new tutor group and meet their new form tutor. Students will then follow a timetable that gives them a flavour of what a typical day at Hungerhill will be like, with all of the lessons following our theme, which is being shared during the transition talks at primary.

Students will need a packed lunch for all three days as they will not be able to buy anything from our canteen until they are fully on roll in September. Students will need to bring a black pen, pencil, ruler, and purple pen with them, we would strongly encourage that they bring a bag as this is part of our uniform in September when they join. Students will need to wear PE kit on Wednesday 8th as they will partake in a PE lesson and another activity which requires PE kit (not spoiling the surprise for this). Students should wear their normal primary school uniform on the other two days.

On Tuesday 7th July there will be two half hour appointments available for you to come and meet your child's form tutor. The first timeslot is at 16.00 and the second timeslot is 16.45. I will shortly send a link to you so that you can book a slot with your child's form tutor.
