Re: GCSE Results Day – Thursday 20 August 2026

We are writing to share information regarding your son/daughter's upcoming GCSE Results Day.

Students are warmly invited to come into school anytime between **9.00am and 10.30am** to collect their results from the examinations hall and celebrate their achievements with staff, friends and family. This is always a special moment, and we very much look forward to sharing it with them. If your child is unable to attend on the day, there are a couple of alternative options available:

- **Email results:** Students may request their results be sent to their school email address. This request must be made in advance by completing the below Microsoft Form. Results will be sent out on Thursday 20 August.
- **Nominate someone to collect:** A student can nominate someone else to collect their results. If the nominated person is a current Hungerhill student, no ID is required. Others must bring valid photo ID (e.g. Driver's Licence or Passport).
- **Access examination results on the new Education Record app from 11am.**

Post-Results Services

If your son/daughter is concerned about a result, we encourage them to speak to their subject teacher on the day. The following services are available:

- **Access to script** – to view a copy of the exam paper.
- **Return of original script** – to receive the original exam paper after results are confirmed.

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- **Clerical check (Service 1)** – a check of all marks and additions.
- **Clerical check with copy of script** – as above, plus a copy of the checked script.
- **Review of marking (Service 2)** – a re-check to ensure the marking was accurate (note: grades can go down as well as up).
- **Review with copy of amended script** – as above, plus the reviewed script.
